ABOUT THE JOB | What will you do?

As a Risk Analytics Officer, you will use your skillset to facilitate the delivery of high-quality data insights. You will be responsible for the following activities:

- Monitoring and reporting the development of credit risk to the management
- Optimising the risk reward relationship within the bank's credit portfolio
- Planning for data capture and structuring of in-house databases
- Developing and maintaining statistical models for risk assessment
- Ensuring that the credit risk procedures, routines and tools are supported by statistically valid data, and that the data is managed in a way that protects the integrity, consistency and security of the data
- Developing reporting formats, and report relevant figures to the Risk Department and the Credit Risk Committee on a regular basis
- Developing, implementing and maintaining different score cards for application scoring, behavioural scoring, etc.
- Preparing documents and reports for evaluation in the Credit Risk Committee, attending the meetings and assisting the Chief Risk Officer in the follow-up

- University degree, preferably in statistics, or any quantitative field
- Strong background from quantitative and statistical analysis and modelling, preferably related to consumer behaviour and/or risk management
- Experience with different statistical tools and methodologies, particularly R, Python and SQL
- Knowledge of risk management methodologies and regulatory capital requirements for credit risk
- Working experience in business analysis or statistical analysis building empirical models
- Background from banking, finance, insurance, credit card industry or consultancy is an asset
