SOFTWARE TEST AUTOMATION ENGINEER TRAINEE

ABOUT THE JOB | What will you do?

As a Software Test Automation Engineer Trainee, you will be responsible for the following activities:

- Contribute to the bank's test approach covering various applications (fronted/backend) and workflows
- Review and analyse business requirements (user stories) and acceptance criteria
- Establish or update a database for (automated) regression tests
- Automate manual tests to ensure specific quality levels with regards to business requirements
- Report, investigate and document identified quality issues and defects
- Suggest solutions to solve identified defects
- Collaborate with Product Delivery, Application Development team members and other delivery team members
- Proactively identify and suggest improvements of QA procedures and processes

Depending on your profile, your responsibilities will be focused on either of these two sets of activities:

Test Automation

- Collaborate with other test automation engineers in the selection, design, development and maintenance of automated test cases
- Analyse the efficiency and return-on-investment of test automation by setting up and monitoring various KPIs
- Participate in proof-of-concept and prototyping initiatives.

Test Coordination

- Generate high and low-level test cases covering business requirements in appropriate testing tools
- Prepare test data for test execution
- Support integration testing activities of system components in cross-functional teams
- Document test executions and test results on different test environments.
